










MAP ACCESS TO CHUBU



THE CHUBU REGION

The Chubu region, made up of nine prefectures, is situated in the center of Honshu, the largest of the Japanese islands. It offers both gorgeous nature and modern cities. The region's prefectures are: Aichi, Mie, Gifu, Nagano, Toyama, Ishikawa, Fukui, Shizuoka, and Shiga.



01 / Aichi Prefecture

This well-developed prefecture centers on Nagoya City, one of Japan's three major metropolises. It is a center of culture for Japan's Chubu region, as well as a center of transport with its Central Japan International Airport (Centrair). Furthermore, as the location of the headquarters of international auto manufacturer Toyota, Aichi also serves as a center for the manufacturing industry that supports Japan.



02 / Mie Prefecture

This prefecture is home to Ise Jingu (Ise Grand Shrine), the head shrine of Japan's traditional Shinto religion. Since olden times, the people of Japan have considered the Ise Jingu a place one must visit at least once in their lives. It's a famous "power spot" known to everyone in the country. In visiting the shrine, one can also take the Kumano Kodo path - famous as a World Heritage Site.



03 / Gifu Prefecture

Gifu is a place where nature, history, and people exist in harmony. It is famous as the base of Oda Nobunaga, one of the three great heroes of Japan's Warring States period. It is also known for Gifu Castle, perched upon Mt. Kinkazan; Takayama, where ancient Japanese towns still remain; and Shirakawa-go, a village of houses with steep thatched roofs that has been certified as a World Heritage Site.


INUYAMA

INUYAMA is a city in the northwestern part of AICHI prefecture, which belongs to central Japan. INUYAMA is located where the KISO River debouches into the NOUBI plain, and has prospered as a key junction of transportation since the old days.

In the SENGOKU era (the age of provincial wars) around the 16th century, many battles were staged around this city. After this war period INUYAMA have developed as a castle town and still today many historical sights (such as INUYAMA castle, a national treasure) are left as they were in those old days. With beautiful nature, a long history, and attractions, we assure you a perfect vacation in INUYAMA.

TAKAYAMA

Located in the northern part of Gifu Prefecture, Takayama is a castle town featuring Takayama Castle, erected in the 16th century. With its rows of ancient wooden structures, traditional scenery still remains in Takayama. The Takayama Festival, started in the 16th - 17th centuries, is one of the three most beautiful festivals of Japan. In this festival one can find yatai (festival floats) and marionettes made with the traditional techniques of the Hida area, as well as lion dances taking place all over the town. The Takayama Festival is held every year in spring and fall; the spring festival is centered on Hie Shrine, while the fall festival centers on Sakura Hachimangu Shrine.


TOBA

Toba City is located on the northeast tip of Mie Prefecture's Shima Peninsula. As the castle town of the Kuki Clan who governed the area since the 17th century, and as a port of landing for visitors of the Ise Jingu travelling by sea, this city is part of the Ise-Shima National Park.

Ise Bay is dotted with numerous islands, including Mikimoto Pearl Island and Dolphin Island. The Pearl Island, connected to the city by the Pearl Bridge, was the first island in the world to successfully cultivate pearls. On the island one can find a pearl factory model and pearl museum; one can also observe the pearl-making process and watch female pearl divers at work. The Toba Aquarium is also a much-frequented attraction, offering around 850 varieties of marine life kept in an environment similar to their natural habitats.



Centrair International Airport is the best place shop for "omiyage" (souvenir). You can basically get all the famous Nagoya food here – from tebasaki, unagi, to uino (Japanese sweet) and instant noodles such as ramen, kishimen and udon. Approximately 100 retail stores can be found at Sky Town on the fourth floor. It also houses most of Nagoya's famous restaurants such as Maruya for unagi rice, Yamachan for tebasaki and Yabaton for miso katsu.

It is best to make a pit stop at the Tourist Information Centre to collect some travel-related brochures. Free Wi-Fi service is being offered too. Staffs here can communicate in English, Chinese, and Korean. They also have a same-day baggage delivery service available for foreign travelers visiting Japan (a fee is required).

If you are heading to the Gifu region, remember to collect your Shoryudo 3 Day Pass. The pass costs 6000yen and it will cover your airport transfer for today, plus all your bus rides to and fro from the Gifu region. Such good value for money! The pass can be purchased from japanican.com.

There are two ways to get to Nagoya City:

- 1 Airport Bus to Downtown Nagoya (Sakae/Fushimi, 50 minutes) – 1000yen.
- 2 Nagoya Railroad (Meitetsu) to Nagoya Station – Limited Express (870yen, 33 minutes); uSky (1230yen, 28 minutes).

If you are traveling alone or in pair, it is better to take the airport bus as most subway stations do not have escalators. Since we were traveling in a group, the train is the fastest way to the city. From Nagoya Station, we shared a cab to our hotel (about 800yen).




