Da Nang International Airport has been creating new flight connections with other East Asian countries and increasing the flight numbers, which has drastically raised the number of international tourists.

Central Japan International Airport, with the purpose of increasing Central Japan visitors in Central Vietnam's and Da Nang city, has been welcoming flight routes and now, with the signature of this MOU for partnership, we are aiming to improve the exchange and relations in between both Airports, in order to strength the cooperation and implement regular direct flights.

① About Sister and Friend Airports

Central Japan International Airport has 5 sister and friend airports: Munich International Airport (Germany, from February 2005), Taichung International Airport (Taiwan, from April 2017), Paine Field (U.S. from April 2017), Seattle-Tacoma International Airport (U.S. from October 2018) and the current Da Nang International Airport (Vietnam, from February 2019).

② About Na Dang City

- It is Central Vietnam most populated city with a population of 1 million.
- With its recent development as a Beach Resort, multiple Asian and Western hotels brands are launching. Since being the city holding APEC (Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation) in 2017, they have been aiming to become an international beach resort and convention city.
- There are some World Heritage Sites in the surroundings, such as Hue, Hoi An and My Son.
- The annual foreign visitors are 2.5 million approx. (2017's data). With a majority of direct flight travelers from South Korea 810 thousand approx., China 430 thousand approx. and Japan 102 thousand approx.

② About Na Dang International Airport

- Usage: Shared between Vietnam People's Air Force and public flights
- Management: Air ports Corporation of Vietnam
 - *Holds the management of 23 airports in Vietnam including Da Nang.
- Site Area: 820ha (670ha Military and 150 public)
- Runway: 2 runways (3,500m and 3,048m)
- Terminal Building: 2 buildings (Terminal 1 Domestic, built in 2011 and Terminal 2 International, built in 2017)
- Annual Travelers: 10,790,000 travelers (2017's data)
- Number of flights: Direct flights to Japan. Vietnam Airlines (Narita-Da Nang and Kansai-Da Nang 7 flights respectively). Central Japan International Airport has from 2017 2 flights with Vietnam Airlines and 4 charter flights with Vietjet Air.
