Central Japan International Airport is pleased to announce the opening of "Sample Kobo Centrair Store" on the 4th floor of Terminal 1 on December 1st, 2020.

Founded in Gujo Hachiman, Gifu Prefecture, a town known by their sample food, recreations of foods in resin and other materials. The opening of "Sample Kobo" in Centrair will allow this Japanese world-class manufacture to be enjoyed by travellers from all over the world. The sample manufacture may have changed its materials from wax during its beginnings in Showa era (1926-1989) to the nowadays resin and silicon, however the manufacturing method that spares no time and effort to elaborate realistic items by hand is highly valued as part of Japanese culture.

Sample Kobo will have original products such as key chains, magnets, smartphone goods, and accessories that can serve as souvenirs, as well as food samples of dishes that cannot be found anywhere else. It will include an exhibition of artistic works so realistic that visitors will want to eat, and a golden food sample exhibition, the only one in Japan.
