

Alice Dining closure announcement

Central Japan International Airport announces the closure of "Alice Dining" restaurant from May 9th, 2021.

Alice Dining is a French restaurant produced by chef Yutaka Ishinabe, one of Japan's top French chefs. This restaurant has welcomed during its 16 years of operation many VIPs guest of Centrair, and has served as a wedding venue for over 600 couples who wanted to celebrate their important day in our airport.

Alice Dining has been continued serving thanks to the patronage of its guests, however due to the significant decrease in airport users caused by the spread of COVID19 last year, the demand for large banquets including weddings has decreased. In view of the changes in the market environment and tendencies it has been decided to close business on May 9th.

We would like to express our sincere gratitude to everyone for their patronage over the 16 years since its opening in February 2005.
