

FLIGHT PARK renewal announcement

Interactive digital content will be discontinued on March 31, 2021

Central Japan International Airport Co., Ltd. announces the discontinuation of FLIGHT PARK, located on the 1st floor of FLIGHT OF DREAMS on March 31, 2021. The venue will remain closed from April 1st for renewal works.

FLIGHT PARK opened in October 2018 as an interactive digital content area based on the display of the first-ever Boeing 787 and has been visited by customers interested in the aviation world. However, during the review of the facility operation it was concluded that due to the spread of COVID infection and the changes in the market environment, FLIGHT PARK will be discontinued and renewed to a new management format. We would like to express our deepest gratitude to all FLIGHT PARK visitors.

This renewal will provide customers with special experiences built around the Boeing 787 aircraft and provide a more enjoyable and comfortable time at the airport. The area will be reborn as a facility with plenty of information surrounding the worlds of aviation and airport operations. Details will be announced in the future.

We will continue to put the safety of our customers and employees first until the last day of business; thoroughly implementing infection prevention measures such as temperature measurement, masks, social distance, and disinfection of equipment and facilities.

Boeing Store located the 1st floor of the FLIGHT OF DREAMS and SEATTLE TERRACE on the 2nd and 3rd floors will continue open after the closure of FLIGHT PARK on April 1st and while renewal construction works are carried out. (Business hours are subject to change due to measures against the spread COVID19).

In addition, the business times of the flight simulator on the 1st floor will be announced as soon as it is decided.
