

## About Renewal opening of Flight Park

Chubu Centrair International Airport announces that the "Flight Park" on the first floor of the "Flight of Dreams" commercial complex will be reopened on December 23, 2021, after being temporarily closed for renovation work since April 1, 2021.

The new Flight Park will be free of charge. As visitors no longer have to pay the entrance fee, they can enjoy the sheer scale and power of the first-ever Boeing 787 (ZA001) easily.

In this renewal, new contents will be provided mainly in two areas, the "Exhibition Area" and the "Kids Area". In those areas, there will be new exhibits and playground equipment for learning about aviation and airports, with the aim of creating a facility that can contribute to child-rearing and learning in the community. Details of each content will be announced shortly.

- Hours of operation 10:00-17:00 (open all year round)

### < Exhibition Area >

This is an area where visitors can enjoy learning about aviation and airports through the display of first-ever Boeing 787 (ZA001), and videos and panels.

### < Kids Area >

This is an area where children can play while feeling the power of real airplanes up close with various playground equipment for children from 0 to 12 years old.

In conjunction with the reopening of the Flight Park, a new store is scheduled to open in Seattle Terrace, the food and beverage sales area on the second floor.

The Boeing Store and the flight simulator (fee-based) will remain open.
