

Chubu Centrair International Airport Winter Schedule 2021

Central Japan International Airport Co., Ltd. notifies the change of Chubu Centrair International Airport flight schedule to Winter Schedule 2021. (From October 31st, 2021, to March 26th, 2022)

The numbers displayed are counted as of November 1st.

1. International flights

Passenger flights: 17 flights per week (round trip)

(5 flights in November 2020, 455 flights in November 2019)

- Philippine Airlines Manila Route: Resumed operations 4 flights a week on June 17th, 2020.
- Cebu Pacific Air Manila Route: Resumed operations 2 flights a week on September 8th, 2020.
- China Airlines Taipei Route: Resumed operations once a week on September 10th, 2020.
- Korean Air Seoul Route: Resumed round-trip service once a week on November 13th, 2020.
- Singapore Airlines Singapore Route: Resumed operations 3 flights a week on December 2nd, 2020.
- Asiana Airlines Seoul Route: Resumed operations once a week on December 14th, 2020.
- Delta Airlines Detroit Route: Resumed operations once a week from April 4th, 2021
- Thai Airways Bangkok Route: Resumed operations 4 flights a week from July 1st, 2021,
*4 flights a week from winter schedule

<Movements during the winter timetable>

- Finn Air Helsinki route: Scheduled to resume operations 2 flights a week in February, 2022
(7 flights a week in the summer schedule for 2022).
- Lufthansa Airlines Frankfurt: Scheduled to resume operation 3 flights a week in March, 2022.

Cargo flights: 41 flights per week (round trip)

(26 flights in November 2020, 27 flights in November 2019)

2. Domestic flights

Passenger flights: 62 flights per day (round trip)

(62 flights in November 2020, 88 flights in November 2019)

3. Overview from 2020

- The number of international passenger flights reached a new record high of 486 per week in January 2020, but due to the spread of the COVID19 infections, all flights were suspended from April 1st to June 16th, 2020. Since then, some routes have resumed operations.
- The number of domestic passenger flights was 97 per day as of January 1, 2020, but due to the spread of COVID19 it reached the lowest frequency recorded with 21 flights per day on May 1, 2020. Since then, the number of flights has been recovering.
